
# Our commitment to you

# Preparing for a new way of working

We are changing the way we do things to maintain high standards of hygiene and social distancing in the following ways:



### **Social Distancing**

We have modified the shared spaces with new seating layouts to allow you to maintain a safe distance from your colleagues and other members.



#### Increased cleaning

We have followed government and WHO guidance on cleaning and are increasing the disinfection of frequently used areas and providing complimentary sanitization products.



#### **Communication & Signage**

Friendly reminders of the new hygiene and social distancing standards will be strategically placed throughout the space for members, guests and staff to remind everyone to do their bit in ensuring our community remains safe. Simple hygiene and distancing measures go a long way in fighting covid-19.

## Our enhanced standards

Members can expect heightened cleaning and hygiene standards that align with WHO and Government Guidance.

#### This includes:

 Hand sanitizer throughout the building in key locations (entrance and exit, kitchen spaces, bathrooms and lift)



Increased frequency of cleaning in high traffic areas

- Provision of gloves and other protective equipment for the Square Works team
- Introduction of single use, recyclable cutlery, cups and daily products in kitchens




## **Entrance**

#### **ENHANCED STANDARDS**

The entrance to Square Works will have clear signage which emphasizes the importance of social distancing, hygiene and sanitation. This will remind members, staff and guests that the community as a whole have an important role to play to ensure the well-being of everyone at Square Works. Hand sanitizer will also be in place for use before entering the building.

To ensure you can still speak to our community team face to face, a clear screen will be installed at reception to ensure the safety of both members and the Square Works team. Floor stickers will also reinforce recommended distancing guidelines to prevent a build up of people at reception. Hand sanitizer will be located on the reception desk.




# **Shared Spaces**

ENHANCED STANDARDS: Cafe, atrium & kitchens

These spaces are the heart of Square Works, giving you a space to break from work, collaborate and meet with others. We're modifying the layouts in these spaces to ensure they provide a safe place in which to do these things.

Capacity in these spaces will be modified to ensure social distancing can be maintained by removing and rearranging furniture.

To ensure our kitchens meet the highest standards of health and safety, tea towels will be replaced with paper towel dispensers, soap dispensers and hygiene guidance will be provided at sinks and usage will be limited to one person at a time.




# **Shared spaces**

**ENHANCED STANDARDS** 

### Phone booths & meeting rooms

Phone booths will be cleaned throughout the day and meeting rooms after every use. Sanitizing wipes will also be provided, allowing members to clean surface themselves. Tissues will be provided in each of these spaces for use by members and bins with lids will also be provided to ensure high levels of hygiene. Meeting room occupancies will be updated to ensure social distancing can be maintained.




# **Shared spaces**

#### Toilets & shower room

As with all our spaces, all washrooms will be cleaned regularly. 20-second hand washing guidance will also be displayed as a reminder of the importance of simple hygiene steps to tackle coronavirus. Usage of bathrooms will be limited to one person at a time. If using the shower, members are to inform reception after use so that it can be cleaned. The shower will not be available at weekends as we cannot ensure hygiene standards are maintained at these times.

We're lucky to have tall ceilings to encourage air flow in the building but windows and doors will be opened at the start of each day to ensure fresh air circulates through-out the building. We encourage members to use the air conditioning units and windows to ensure air flow in their offices.
